# 1) Introductions and Apologies

There was a repeat of the previous discussions about space for everyone and WiFi connection.














and volunteers. Everyone is pleased about this.

- said they are welcome, but suggested other centres could start their own book clubs and then they could all meet up?
- asked if they had audio books too? They don't at the moment, but they could if people needed them.

shared some good news for a person we support.

Someone who attended Monday to Friday could not make all 5 days because he injured his foot.

Luckily there was space at Oakenholt so now he goes there for part of the week.









## 5) Anything else

The meeting was a bit disrupted from 11:30 onwards as a car alarm kept going off outside – it was a Wirral Council works van parked right outside the meeting room accessible doors.

All agreed that the hybrid meetings (some people face-to-face and some on Zoom) are not really working for this group.

suggested we all use the same 'traffic light cards' as the Day Services Co-production Group. Maybe the centres could have their own cards so people on Zoom could use them too. All agreed.

Action:

will bring 'traffic light cards' to next meeting.

If we move SUBH to 1 week later (2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of the month), we can discuss the agenda and feed into the Committee meeting.


There is no Committee meeting in August so nothing needs to change until September.
